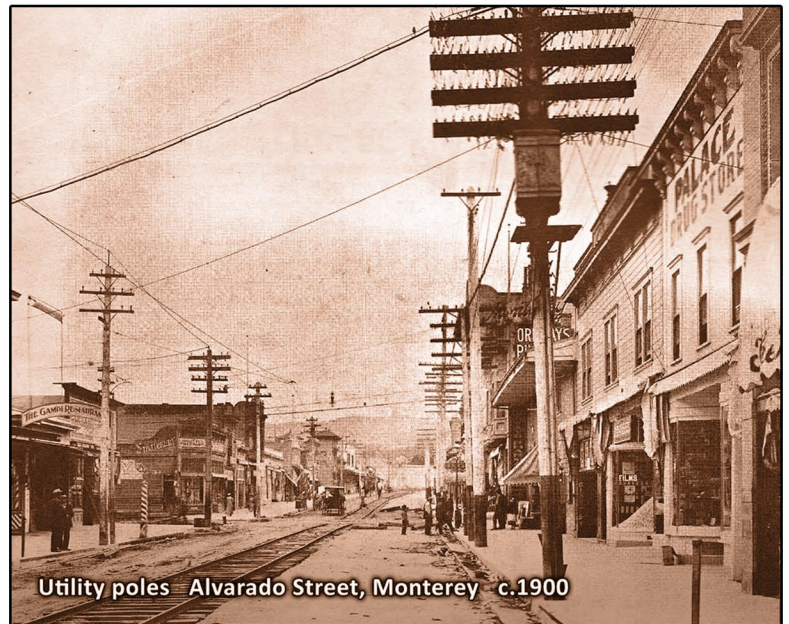
THE URGENCY, THE PROCESS, & HOW TO PAY FOR IT

Investigators confirm that PG&E power lines started deadly Camp Fire

Fire authorities have officially determined that Pacific Gas and Electric Co. was responsible for last year's deadly Camp Fire in Paradise, California which burned a total of 153,336 acres and killed 85 people, making it the "deadliest and most destructive"
